

Visa and Covid-19 Health Guidelines

Visa Applications/Appointments to Travel to Malta

→ **Turkish citizens & holders of Turkish residency permit (minimum 6-months validity + Covid-19 requirements):**

Visa applications & appointment requests can be submitted directly to VFS Global via <https://visa.vfsglobal.com/tur/en/mlt> or call +90 2123 7358 03

→ **All other 3rd country nationals:**

Visa requests are to be forwarded to the Central Visa Unit at visa.ima@gov.mt for guidance.

Covid-19 Health Measures to Travel to Malta

→ All passengers travelling to Malta must comply with COVID-19 measures and requirements at <https://deputyprimeminister.gov.mt/en/health-promotion/covid-19/Pages/travel.aspx>

→ All passengers are required to submit a completed Passenger Locator Form online at <https://app.euplf.eu/#/>

→ Passengers travelling to Malta in exceptional circumstances from dark red countries/zones must complete the Travel Authorisation and Alternative Quarantine Location Request at <https://travelauthorisation.gov.mt/>

Travel to Turkey

→ Maltese citizens, holding a valid Maltese passport, and travelling to Turkey for tourist or business purposes, can travel without a visa for visits of up to 90 days in any 180-day period.

→ All passengers travelling to Turkey are advised to follow the COVID-19 regulations and Health Measures in force at the time of travel at www.turkishairlines.com/en-int/announcements/coronavirus-outbreak/travel-restrictions/

→ All passengers (except transit passengers & passengers under 6 years of age) must submit a Traveller Entry Form at <https://register.health.gov.tr/>
