The public announcement for 'Interuniversity Master on Diplomacy and International Relations' at the Spanish Diplomatic School, for 2020/21 has been issued. Non Diplomatic Candidates

Non Diplomatic Candidates must sit an entrance test/interview before at the Embassy of Spain for which all the non diplomat applicants will be called.

To make the most of this Master Programme, applicants must have a high level of Spanish which can be proved by presenting a certificate of the DELE Nivel B2 (Diploma of Spanish as a Foreign Language). Applicants must possess at least an Honours Degree by a recognised University or equivalent and have a minimum of 7 out of 10 in his/her academic record, obtained before 1st April 2020.

The deadline to submit the application and all documentation is **1st April 2020**. A copy of the Spanish application form, and MFEA application form which can be downloaded from the Ministry for Foreign and European Affairs website <https://foreignandeu.gov.mt/en/Pages/Scholarships.aspx> are to be sent to the Scholarship Section at the Ministry for Foreign and European Affairs
