

Testimonial

One of the conditions for a candidate applying and chosen to take a specific scholarship is to prepare a short testimonial in the form of a write-up supported with photographs and/or a short video related directly to the particular scholarships beneficiaries' experience during the awarded course/fellowship:

1. What was the scope of the scholarship?
2. What was the agenda of the scholarship?
3. Was the course managed in a professional way?
4. Did you have any sharing of experiences and ideas with other foreign participants?
5. What benefits have you derived from the scholarship?
6. Was the scholarship relevant to your work?
7. Mention two outstanding aspects which may not be necessarily academic which in your view rendered the scholarship a unique experience
8. Would you encourage others to take this scholarship in the future?

Please note that the testimonial is not restricted to the above questions only, but these will serve as guidelines to the same testimonial which you have to submit to MFEA Scholarships Unit. Any other relevant experience obtained during the scholarship can be included in the testimonial.

The completed testimonial should reach the Scholarships Unit within the Consular Services Unit within **30 working days** from end of the specific course. Failing to submit the aforesaid testimonial will be taken into account for any future scholarship application submitted by the awarded beneficiary.
